



## Summary of Proposed Changes to the Bylaws

### Board Structure

At the August 2009 Board Retreat, the effectiveness of the current TIA Board structure was reviewed. It was felt that the current structure, i.e. industry-elected seats and seats for designated organizations, was effective, but there would be benefits to redefining some specific seats.

The following changes will be recommended at this year's Annual General Meeting. Current elected seats will transition as terms expire, over 2010 and 2011 elections; designated organization seats will transition at the 2010 AGM.
